





Data Compilation

- Each search query resulted in a list of registered charitable organizations.
- All search query results were combined; duplicates were removed.
- Each "hit" (i.e. registered organization) listed a summary of the tax return filed by the organization for each year, dating back to 5 years. For example, a search performed in 2022, provided tax return summaries for the five years 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2021.
- The return included a list of office holders (and sometimes, their positions) for each year of the 5-year period.
- For each year, each listed office holder was analyzed for gender (male or female), based on first name recognition. If required, further analysis was performed using: Google® image search, LinkedIn search and gender analysis of the first name.
- The board of each registered organization was broken down into the number of males and females, for each tax year from 2014-2022.






Data Analysis




Number of Registered Charities over Time






No. of Board Positions per Year






Percentage of Women in Board Positions









Number of Provincial Organizations 2022






2022: % of Women on Boards











Tier 2: Percentage of Women on Boards vs Year























2022 Results: Municipal Tier 1 (7 or more organizations)





2022 Tier 1: Cities with 7 or more organizations


Tier 1: # of Organizations





2022 Tier 1: % of Women on Boards


Tier 1: Percentage of Women on Boards


2022 Results: Municipal Tier 2 (3-6 organizations)





2022 Tier 2: Cities with 3-6 organizations


2022 Tier 2 - No. of organizations (3-6)





Tier 2 - % of women on boards


